- Completed by the Project Partners Estonia, Germany (Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania), Finland and Ireland
- Through a series of structured questions assembles a step-by-step profile of the management and transition of High Risk Prisoners from committal to custody to resettlement in the community

- Question 2 Please briefly describe <u>Court sentence or other orders</u> /requirements imposed at sentencing that influence or impact on transition management or post-custody supervision/management of high risk offenders. E.g. Post custody supervision order, sex offender registration/reporting etc.





- Question 3 Please briefly describe <u>sentence management or</u> <u>other processes during sentence in custody</u> that influence, have relevance to or make a contribution to the transition management or post-custody supervision/management of high risk offenders. E.g. Sentence management systems, relevant interventions etc.
- Question 4 Please briefly describe <u>in-custody assessment and</u> <u>evaluation processes</u> that influence or contribute to planning and decision making in preparation for transition management or post-custody supervision/management of high risk offenders. E.g. risk/need assessment, assessment for group or individual programmes etc.





- Question 5 Please briefly describe transition management and related processes prior to release from custody that have relevance or make a contribution to the transition management or post-custody supervision/management of high risk offenders. E.g. multidisciplinary/agency planning/interventions, personal plans, case conferences, etc.
- Question 6 Please briefly describe post-custody supervision/management and related processes <u>after custody</u> that have relevance to or make a contribution to the post-custody supervision of high risk offenders. E.g., authorities involved, frequency of contact etc.
