Dr. Ineke Pruin speaks on “Research on Transition Management” (**Paper No.1**).

Dr. Ulrike Schütt and Dipl. Psych. Wiebke Boberg speak on „Diagnosis and Prognosis at the Diagnostic Centre of Waldeck Prison” (**Paper No.2**).

Mr. Volker Horstmann, Criminal Judge at Rostock Court, speaks on “FoKuS – For optimal Control and Security” (**Paper No.3**).

Mr. Ulf Theodor Claassen, Colonel CID, Police Headquarters Rostock, speaks on “FoKuS – police duties in supervised release” (**Paper No.4**).

After a plenary discussion of the papers above, the audience is divided in 4 different parallel workshops with the following topics:

- 1) Legislation
- 2) Sentence Planning and Treatment
- 3) Transition Management and Release
- 4) Reintegration, Aftercare and Monitoring





These topics are discussed in the parallel workshops with the aim to come to Best Practice Strategies and Programms within the discussed field resulting in a Model and Standards that can be true for all of Europe.

The parallel workshops continue until Friday morning in order for the results to be presented in the audience on Friday late morning and afternoon.

The presentation of each workshop is followed by a plenary discussion leading to a conclusion of possible “Minimum European Standards” for everyone of the four fields.
