### Summary of the Evaluation Forms

35 evaluation sheets were received from participants at the end of the workshop. Ratings were consistently high on all subsections of the sheet. The average rating – total is 9,0.

**Organisational Aspects:** The minimum rating was 7 with the majority of response at 9 and 10.

**Contents:** The minimum rating in this section was 5. The great majority of responses were at 8, 9 and 10.

**Methodologies:** The rating was between 5 and 10 in this section. The majority of responses were at 8, 9 and 10.

**Skills of Experts:** The level of rating was high in this section with almost all over 7. In addition, the majority of responses at 8, 9 and 10. In the level of involvement question there was one response in 3 and three in 5.

**Atmosphere:** The great majority of responses in this section was at 9 and 10.

**General evaluation:** The majority of responses in this section were at 9 and 10. There were only two responses at 7 and one at 6.

**Comments:** Only a small number of additional written comments received in this section and were in general positive and appreciative.
